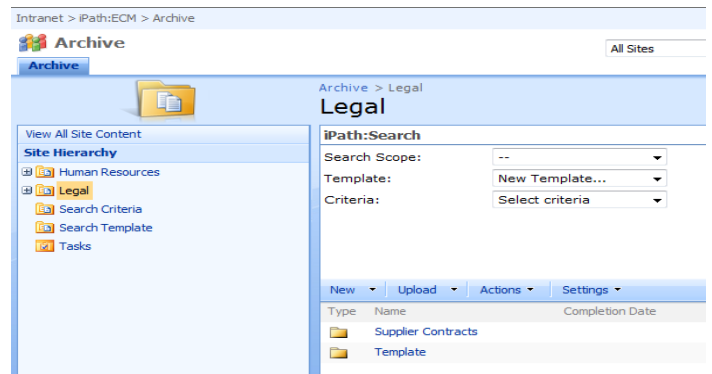


iPath:Search for SharePoint

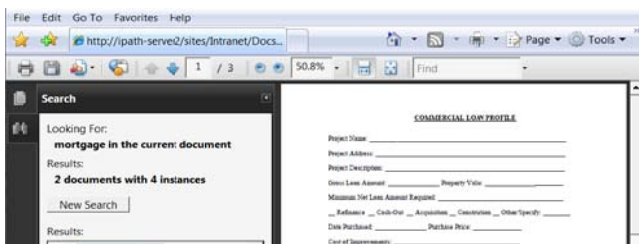

One of the key capabilities of Enterprise Content Management (ECM) solutions is the ability to search through all or part of the content stored in the enterprise, and to find the information you are looking for, promptly and securely. The majority of enterprise content is unstructured in the form of electronic documents, emails, forms, etc. Searching through the textual content of unstructured content can be a daunting task as it is highly likely the search operation will return a large amount of possible results. In an effort to provide users the ability to find the information they are looking for very quickly, ECM solutions provide the ability to associate metadata with documents, thus adding structure to unstructured content; and provide the ability to search through the metadata delivering very precise and granular results. iPath:Search enhances the search operations available in MOSS 2007 and SharePoint 2010. It extends the out-of-the-box search capabilities of SharePoint by enabling users to construct precise search queries on any desired set of available metadata associated with any document or folder content type. It is a simple, intuitive, easy to use and powerful search module allowing users to rapidly find the information they are looking for.

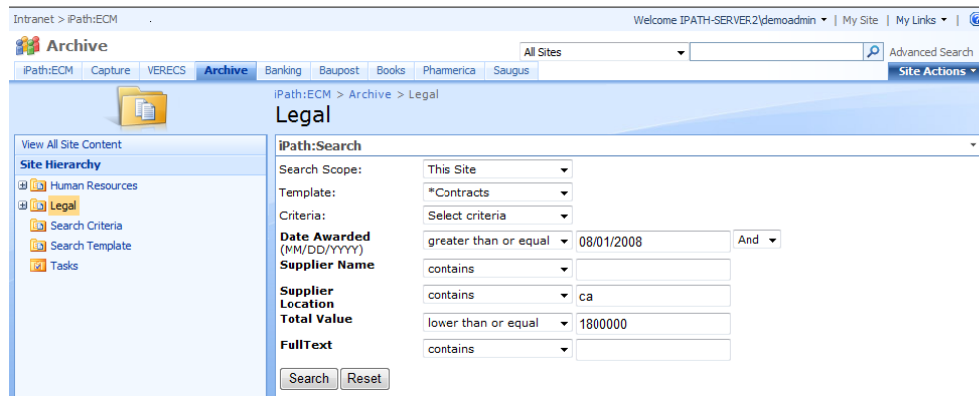

Features

Search Engine

- Uses Microsoft Enterprise Search with Managed Properties to locate Site folders and documents.

Full-Text Search

- Supports standard full-text search operators: equals, not equal, contains, does not contain.
- Supports Not logic and prefix-matching wildcard searches.
- Highlights search hits in documents and lets you navigate between them.

Metadata Search

- Search documents that don't have any text.
- Supports text, numeric, and date columns.
- Supports standard metadata search operators: equals, not equal, contains, does not contain, less than, less than or equal, greater than, greater than or equal, begins with, does not begin with, and date and numeric ranges.
- Supports Not, Or, and And logic and prefix-matching wildcard searches.
- Searches for specific content types and metadata columns and understands their relationship.

Search Screens

- Save time and effort on repetitive searches with search screens.
- Administrators and power users can create custom search screens for specific business purposes.
- Search screens are available to authorized users and are easy to use.
- Tailor search screens to specific document libraries, content types, and metadata columns.
- Configure different search screens on different pages and for different users.
- Save search templates and search criteria.

Search Results

- View search results and act on them in the search results window.
- Sort search results by column.
- Open items in the search results and perform actions on them, like print or e-mail.
- Save search results, open in Excel, or print them.
- Search results are security trimmed, so that users only see items in the search results that they are authorized to see.
